

Crafts Basic Set Up Shopping List

Table & chairs for children (adults to supervise but not take over!)
Plastic table cloth or table top you can easily wipe clean
Aprons for children (and helpers?)
Paintbrushes & Rollers
Glue Sticks - Runny PVA glue (glitter glue rather than loose glue unless you are OK with glitter! Parents don't always appreciate glitter at home!)
Paints non toxic and washable
Card/ Board and paper
Marker pen for naming craft
Rolls of gift ribbon
Sticky tape (on a dispenser)
Stapler
Hole punch
Stumpy crayons (be careful if they get too small)
Cotton buds for painting or applying glue
Craft Lolly sticks
Cotton wool balls/pleats
Sponges cut up for sponge painting
Ice cream containers for storage and lids for using as palettes
Pipe cleaners in multi colours and multi skin colours
Paper plates- an essential resource!
Stocks of Tissue paper, crepe, shiny paper
Fabric scraps (sorted into fur, felt, fabric etc)
Crinkled/shredded paper
Packaging - boxes, etc
Craft hole punches and stamps (novelty shapes)
Star hole punch
Specialist and recycled craft papers and cards
Adult scissors (out of reach to children)
Magazine pictures of people, magazines, wrapping paper

Other useful equipment

Access to Computer for printing off bible messages, texts etc, clip art (there are specific Christian clip art discs available from good Christian retail outlets, particularly the 'Quickart' range)
Guillotine (large for A4 and A3)
Access to Photocopier
Laminating machine
Washing line - string with pegs for hanging up the pictures

Bowl for handwashing nearby (supervised) paper towels for hand drying)
